INSTITUTIONAL EFFECTIVENESS COMMITTEE BYLAWS

- NAME:** College of Nursing and Allied Health: Institutional Effectiveness Committee
- PURPOSE:** To improve institutional effectiveness by directing the application of College wide research methods in order to evaluate program outcomes, student success, and faculty effectiveness
- FUNCTIONS:** The functions of the committee shall include:
- Integrate divisional resource needs from assessment data to develop the strategic plan
 - Analyze data and outcomes by comparison to thresholds. Utilize findings to recommend program improvements
 - Track action plans for unmet outcomes to resolution
 - Direct the collection and measurement of program review data and recommend plans for improvement
 - Aggregate data identified in program reports and communicate resource needs
 - Design, review, and update the Program Review Plan and related policies, documents, and forms
 - Incorporate regulatory standards into the Program Review Plan
 - Provide consultation and guidance to College committees, faculty and staff. Disseminate report findings
 - Make recommendations to the College Administrative Committee.
- MEMBERSHIP:** Research director, administration, faculty, and staff.
- MEETINGS:** Meetings are held once per month.
