PURPOSE

To identify and prioritize the physical and behavioral health needs of girls entering detention through a validated screening instrument.

PROCEDURE

Every girl entering the juvenile justice system must receive comprehensive, evidence-based and gender-responsive physical and mental health screening and assessment that identifies trauma.

Medical Records/HIM Department will single scan the Medical/Mental health screening assessment into PEMRS/Power chart, under notes for a single document scanning process.

Upon completion of the GHS assessment information should be electronically transmitted to Health Care Providers through PEMRS/Message Center for the continuity of care.

Continuum of care:

- 1. Detention Intake GHS Screen.
- 2. Detention Health Assessment and Treatment.
- 3. Detention Pre-release Planning/Medical Passport.
- 4. Community Agencies Education, Child Welfare.
- 5. Community Health Providers.
