PURPOSE

To describe facility-specific policies and procedures involved with controlled drug storage and control.

POLICY

- All controlled drugs are stored in locked containers.
- Counts of controlled drugs are performed on a regular basis.
- Keys are kept by designated personnel that sign out from shift to shift.

PROCEDURE

For Juvenile Halls and Camps with Pyxis machines:

- 1. All controlled medications are kept in a double-locked cabinet in the Medical Module (and in the Medical Housing Unit at Central Juvenile Hall).
- 2. The key for the locked cabinet is stored in the Pyxis machine.
- At Central Juvenile Hall's Medical Housing Unit (MHU), the controlled medications are located in a locked cabinet with the key controlled by the MHU nurse. Only patient-specific medication is kept at the MHU.
- 4. Controlled medications include narcotics and some psychotropic medications. Counts are done on both.
- Counts of controlled drugs are completed at the beginning and the end of each shift by the outgoing and incoming Nursing Team Leaders (Charge Nurses) and includes signature signoff.
- 6. The individuals performing the counts will not go off-shift until the controlled drug count is completed and signed.
- 7. If an error is made on the signature sheet, a single line is drawn through the error, the word "Error" is written, and the entry is signed with the name and title of the nurse.

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Camps without a Pyxis machine:

- 1. All controlled medications are kept in a double-locked cabinet.
- 2. Only nursing personnel have access to this key which is stored in the designated nursing lock box.
- 3. All counting procedures are described as above.
