PURPOSE

To describe diagnostic services available through Juvenile Court Health Services for the youth population in the detention facilities.

POLICY

JCHS on-site diagnostic services are limited to point-of-care tests (POCT), EKGs, and radiologic evaluations. These diagnostic services meet all applicable County and State regulations. Diagnostic services not provided on-site (e.g., non-POCT labs) are provided at the applicable DHS facilities and approved reference labs.

PROCEDURE

- Youth requiring a diagnostic procedure will have an order entered in PEMRS.
- Any on-site diagnostic procedure is addressed in the appropriate procedure manual.
- Any off-site diagnostic procedure such as radiology procedures will have the appropriate requisition form completed by the clinician.
- All personnel working around a radiology machine will regularly monitor levels of exposure with dosimeters.
- Providers are responsible that any diagnostic studies ordered are scheduled and any results are followed up.
