PURPOSE

To state the Dental Department's procedure on the use of dental floss by juveniles.

The use of dental floss by a youth shall be under the direction of a physician or dentist and by a written order through PEMRS. Youth can verbally request to floss teeth during a dental visit.

PROCEDURE:

Once the need for the use of dental floss is established by one of the above health care providers, the following steps are taken:

- 1. The youth reports to the Medical Unit, Nursing station or Dental clinic.
- 2. The nurse or dental assistant ascertains the written / verbal order for flossing.
- 3. A length of loss is given measuring no more than twelve (12) inches.
- 4. The youth is observed directly while using floss.
- 5. Used dental floss is deposited into infectious waste container under direct observation.
