PURPOSE

To ensure information regarding emergency medication and poison control is readily available to staff.

PROCEDURE

The Pharmacy Supervisor will post the poison control telephone number in areas where overdoses or toxic-dose emergencies may occur in facilities.

The Pharmacy Supervisor will make ensure that the poison control telephone number is updated and in easily utilized area.

The Pharmacy Supervisor will orient all staff as to where to find the poison control telephone number.

Emergency agents (antidotes) and minimum inventory levels are as follows:
