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Policy Statement: Effectively store scrub attire and protect scrub attire from potential contamination. The surgical scrub attire are laundered from a health-care accredited laundry facility to promote infection prevention and control, healthcare worker safety, and facilitate a high level of cleanliness and hygiene.

Procedural Steps: Scrub Suit Access:

Use the Scrubex Dispenser

- 1. Please utilize your employee badge to access scrub.
- 2. Open door as directed by the machine.
- 3. Removed scrubs promptly as directed by the machine.

•Each approved staff will be given floating scrub credits and Jacket credit.

•When you return your scrub you will get your credits back.

•Additional credits will not be given out. Please notify Supply Chain/Warehouse supervisor or O.R .Supervisor. •Scrubs should be checked out and retuned at the beginning and end of each day.

Return Scrubs

- 1. Please use your employee badge to return scrubs.
- 2. Open the door.
- 3. Place TOP/BOTTOM Scrubs as directed.
- 4. The machine will credit scrubs returned.
