SUBJECT: APPOINTMENTS, OFF-UNIT Policy No.: C123.10

Effective Date: 05/1999

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**PURPOSE:** To reduce patient fears and apprehension, confirm patient's understanding and cooperation with the procedure, and ensure safety during transport

PHYSICIAN'S ORDER REQUIRED: No

**PERFORMED BY:** RN, LVN, RA, NA, SNW, USA, and Affiliating Student Nurses (under the direction of an RN within their scope of practice.)

## **POLICY STATEMENTS:**

- 1. The Transportation/Lift Team will transport patients whenever possible.
- 2. Patients will be transported with the same level of monitoring provided on their unit e.g., Care Companion.
- 3. A completed SBAR Ticket to Ride form will be placed in front of the hard chart.
- 4. The transporter will ensure the SBAR Ticket to Ride form is completed by the sending unit and the diagnostic testing site and returned with the patient to the unit.

### **PROCEDURAL STEPS:**

Licensed nurses will:

- 1. Validate diagnostic test orders and complete necessary preparation
- 2. Document special considerations as necessary when completing SBAR Ticket to Ride form
- 3. Discuss procedure, process, and sequence with patient.
  - **Key Point:** If the procedure requires an "Informed Consent", the physician will discuss and obtain the informed consent prior to the procedure/appointment time.
- 4. Medicate patient as ordered and document in the Electronic Health Record.
  - **Key Point:** If conscious sedation is ordered, patient must be accompanied by a trained RN. Informed consent needs to be sign prior to procedure (refer to policy B815 Moderate and Deep Procedural Sedation in Patients without Controlled Airway).
- 5. Ensure that appropriate staff transport patient to and from appointment.

Licensed/unlicensed nursing employees will:

- Remove all jewelry and metallic materials, if applicable.
   Key Point: If not possible to remove all metallic materials, inform the Department of Medical Imaging (MRI) where the metal is located.
- 7. Encourage patient to void or empty urine drainage bag prior to transport.
- 8. Post procedure, encourage fluids after procedures with contrast media unless contraindicated.

### **PATIENT / FAMILY EDUCATION:**

Discuss procedure, process, preparation, and sequence with patient/family.

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# **DOCUMENTATION:**

1. Document procedure discussion, patient / family education, medication administration, and any untoward patient response to the procedure in the EHR.
