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RISK TO PERSONNEL

Staff may be exposed to bloodborne pathogens in the healthcare setting via body fluids by a variety of means:

- 1. Needles and other sharps
- 2. Mucous membranes (eyes, mouth, nose)
- 3. Cutaneous (open cuts, nicks, skin abrasions)

Specific measures that are instituted to minimize or eliminate the risk of exposure are included under the following sections: Standard Precautions, Engineering Controls, Work Practice Controls, Personal Protective Equipment, Regulated Waste and Hazard Communication.
