# Communication Disorders Department Policy and Procedure

### SUBJECT: TREATMENTAPPROACHES

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## PURPOSE

To outline the types of treatment approaches.

#### POLICY

The patient may be treated in one or more of the following approaches:

- 1. individual sessions
- 2. group sessions
- 3. co-treatment sessions
- 4. community outings

#### PROCEDURES

- 1. Guidelines for selection of different treatment approaches:
  - a. Individual therapy may be indicated when the patient's unique communication, swallowing and/or behavioral deficits require one-on-one intervention.
  - b. Group therapy may be indicated when patients:
    - 1. have similar communication and/or swallowing treatment goals
    - 2. have communication goals related to participation in social contexts
    - 3. will benefit from peer feedback
  - c. Co-treatment is indicated when a patient will benefit from treatment provided concurrently with another discipline (e.g. sensory stimulation, cooking evaluation, early intervention, etc.)
  - d. Community outings may involve individuals or groups who leave the Medical Center grounds in order to address treatment goals to improve communication and/or swallowing skills in community settings. (See Communication Disorders Department Policy- Community Outings)

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#### 2. Guidelines for provision of group treatment:

- a. The structure and focus of each therapy group is designed to meet the individual needs of each patient/participant.
- b. Since the treatment group objectives change, it is the responsibility of speech-language pathologists to develop and implement treatment plans that define:
  - 1. The minimum and maximum number of patients to be treated. The patient therapist ratio not to exceed 4:1.
  - 2. The purpose and definition of the group treatment focus
  - 3. The type of population served
  - 4. The criteria and procedures for enrollment
  - 5. The objectives of treatment
  - 6. The procedure(s) for measurement of progress (including documentation procedures)
