PROCEDURE FOR MAINTAINING TELEMETRY

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Procedure: Telemetry equipment will be maintained following manufacturer recommended maintenance.

Portable telemetry units consists of:

- 1. Transmitters
- 2. PC with telemetry program (Power Supply)

I. With Each Use

- A. Check each unit for the following supplies:
 - 1. Electrodes
 - 2. Alcohol swabs
 - 3. Electrode wire leads
 - 4. Battery
 - 5. Tape
 - 6. Disposable Transmitter bag
- B. Check all electrical cords for broken or exposed wire, or fraying of protective rubber cord cover.

II. Weekly

- 1. Wipe all units and surfaces with appropriate cleaning supplies
- 2. Ensure adequate supply of electrodes in supply area.

III. Biannually

Biomedical department, a division of Facilities Management will perform an electrical check according to hospital policy. A sticker on the transmitters and PC will indicate the date of when these checks were performed.

If the safety check is overdue, report this to the area Supervisor. A work order should be completed requesting an electrical check for patient care equipment.
