

SUBJECT:	PEDIATRIC EMERGENCY DRUG DOSING	Policy No.:	C155
-	SHEET	Effective:	07/1999
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Purpose of Policy: To provide a quick reference for appropriate weight-based dosing of emergency medications to pediatric patients.

Physician Order Required: No

Policy Statements:

- 1. All patients 13 years and under or under 50 kg will have a completed Pediatric Emergency Drug Dosing Sheet available in the patient's chart.
- 2. The Pediatric Emergency Drug Dosing Sheet is accessed from the Rancho Intranet as follows:
 - a. Clinical Practice Support
 - b. DHS Clinical Resources
 - c. Micromedex
 - d. Other tools and Calculators
 - e. ACLS/PALS Guidelines
 - f. Enter pediatric patient's weight in kg then press submit
 - g. Enter patient's name and "print"
- 3. The admitting nurse generates the form and places it in the paper light chart with the label, "Peds Emergency Drug Sheet" on the extended edge.
- 4. The Pediatric Emergency Drug Dosing Sheet will be reviewed and updated, if needed, every month unless the child is undergoing a significant weight change or a growth period warranting more frequent updating.
- 5. Use the Pediatric Emergency Drug Dosing Sheet as the primary dosing guide during a code white and use the Broselow tape as a secondary guide, if needed.
