## **POLICY**

It is the responsibility of the Facility disciplines to immediately report medication errors in Safety Intelligence and notify the responsible practitioner.

<u>Definition of a Medication Error:</u> Any preventable event that may cause or lead to inappropriate medication use or patient harm while the medication is in the control of the healthcare professional, patient, or consumer.

A significant medication error is a medication event that could lead to death, disability, or transfer to a higher level of care.

## **PROCEDURE**

- 1. A medication error will be reported on the facility's intranet on Safety Intelligence.
- 2. The individual initiating the report will follow the prompts in Safety Intelligence and provide a complete report as possible including the medication involved and the circumstances or what precipitated the error.
- 3. The report will be forwarded to the responsible individuals for response.
- 4. All medication errors will be investigated as soon as is reasonably possible, but not later than 2 business days from the date the medication error is discovered.
- 5. An analysis, trend, and recommendation of medication errors will be presented at the monthly P&T Committee by the Medication Safety Committee, a subcommittee of the P&T Committee.
- 6. Other reports (i.e. Pharmacists' Queries and referrals of medication events from facility meetings) will be reviewed, trended, and reported to the P&T Committee.
- 7. All medication error reports and reviews will be immediately retrievable in the pharmacy for at least one year from the date the record was created.

## MEDICATION SAFETY COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITY:

1. Monthly analysis, trends, and recommendations will be presented by the Medication Safety Committee to the P&T Committee for review and action.
