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POLICY

The Inpatient Pharmacy will report to Infection Control any instance when patients are initially prescribed the following medications: crotamiton or permethrin, and anti-HIV medications and when patients receive two or more medications to treat tuberculosis.

PROCEDURE

- 1. The Inpatient Pharmacy receives an order for crotamiton or permethrin, anti-HIV medications, or two or more medications to treat tuberculosis.
- 2. Pharmacy personnel will contact Infection Control at X-57447 to report the patients identification, medication(s), and location .
