## **POLICY**

Unadministered compounded I.V. piggybacks are to be returned to the Inpatient Pharmacy for disposition. This does not apply to I.V. antibiotics which are attached to a Mini-bag Plus adaptor.

## **PROCEDURE**

## 1. Labeling

- a. Compounded I.V. piggybacks have an expiration date  $\leq$  12 hours or in accordance to manufactured product information.
- b. Frozen I.V. piggybacks, after being thawed at room temperature and given an expiration date, based upon manufacturer's recommendation under refrigeration storage.
- c. Returned compounded I.V. piggybacks will be returned to the Inpatient Pharmacy for disposition.
- d. I.V. antibiotics which are attached to a Mini-bag Plus Adaptor, can be reused, utilizing the fifteen day expiration period allotted by the manufacturer.

## 2. Reconciling returns

a. It is the responsibility of the sterile products staff to investigate and reconcile sterile product returns from the patient care areas.
