PURPOSE

To provide guidelines for the care of patients after a fall.

POLICY

The following policy will be implemented to support National Patient Safety Goals and Department of Health Service recommendations to:

- 1. decrease patient injury secondary to falls and
- 2. minimize harm to patients on therapeutic doses of anticoagulants.

PROCEDURE

Following an inpatient fall, the following must be documented:

- 1. Is there conclusive/documented evidence that the patient does not have the potential for head injury?
- 2. In the patient has the potential for head injury, the following procedures must be followed:
 - a) a complete physical examination, including a detailed neurological assessment will be performed by a physician and the results documented;
 - b) subsequent, interval examinations by appropriate personnel will be determined on a clinical basis;
 - c) Head CT will be ordered if there is a possibility of significant head injury, either by history, the physical environment in which the patient is found, or clinical examination;
 - d) if the patient is receiving therapeutic anticoagulant therapy, a head CT will be ordered in all cases of an inpatient fall in which head injury is suspected, regardless of the severity or clinical findings.

PROCEDURE DOCUMENTATION

- 1. Documentation by the responsible in-patient service must include results of the CT scan, if ordered, and follow up neurological findings an all cases.
- 2. Recommendations for additional therapeutic intervention and/or consultation must be documented and results of said consultations recorded and acknowledged.
