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**Purpose of Procedure:** To identify the steps for documentation of patient, significant other, and/or caregiver education in the in-patient setting.

Physician's Order Required: No

Performed By: RN, LVN, and Affiliating Students under the supervision of an RN

## **Policy Statements:**

- 1. The Patient Education Section is initiated at the time of admission. The learning assessment portion is completed before initiating training.
- 2. The Patient Education sections are used to document the outcome of learning.
  - a. Print handouts applicable for the patient based on diagnosis and Interdisciplinary Plan of Care (IPOC).
  - b. Review information with patient/family.
  - c. Under the Education band, select all the sections that apply including Learning Assessment.
  - d. Identify the learner by selecting the Home/Caregiver Name/Relationship.
  - e. All teaching completed during the shift will be documented accordingly.
