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PURPOSE

To ensure that patient treatment is provided under the order and direction of a physician (M.D.).

In addition to an M.D., orders may be received from a Physician Assistant or Nurse Practitioner, within their approved scope of practice.

POLICY

- An M.D. order for occupational therapy and recreation therapy must be present prior to the initial contact and ongoing service; when the patient changes Diagnosis-related Group (DRG) status; or when the patient transfers to another service.
- 2. The treatment plan, and any subsequent major changes in the plan, will be approved by the physician as indicated by his/her signature or electronic signature.

PROCEDURE

 The therapist is responsible for checking that a written or electronic order, or the physician's approval of a program change, is in the patient's health record before initiating contact or treatment.
