SUBJECT: AQUATIC THERAPY PROGRAM FECAL/EMESIS INCIDENT RESPONSE IN THE POOL	Policy No.:	321

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PURPOSE:

Fecal/emesis accidents pose a health and safety risk to patrons. Pool closure is necessary for proper disinfection and protection of the health and safety of patients and other users of the pool.

POLICY:

Fecal/vomiting Accident Response in the pool

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Pool staff that are present in the pool area will direct everyone to leave the pool.
- 2. Pool staff will shut down the pool.
- 3. No one will be allowed to enter the contaminated pool until all decontamination procedures are completed.
- 4. Signage that indicates that pool cannot be used will be placed on all entrance doors of the pool.
- 5. Pool staff will call Facilities Management immediately who will manage the cleanup of the pool
- Facilities Management, Aquatic Therapy Rehabilitation Tech and or Aquatic Therapy Supervisor will be responsible for contacting the contracted pool maintenance company, <u>Pacifica Pools</u> that is responsible for weekly pool maintenance.
- 7. Pool will be closed until Facilities Management notifies the Aquatic Therapy Supervisor that pool can be open for operation.
