SUBJECT: HAZARD SURVEILLANCE PROGRAM POLICY NO. 423

PURPOSE:

To establish the responsibility for, and components of, the hospital's Hazard Surveillance Program.

POLICY:

Harbor-UCLA Medical Center's Safety Officer will ensure that an ongoing hospital-wide hazard surveillance program is maintained to collect and evaluate information about hazards and safety practices. All areas where individuals are served will be surveyed at least semi-annually and other areas, at least annually. Surveillance summaries and corrective actions will be shared with the Environment of Care Committee.

PROCEDURE:

A. Surveillance

- 1. Hazard surveillance may include, but is not limited to, the following:
 - Hazard Surveillance Surveys
 - Environmental Rounds
 - Mechanical Quality Inspections
 - Nursing Safety Audits/Monitors
 - Unsafe Condition Reports
 - Product Recalls
 - Employee Suggestion Box Submissions

B. Follow-up and Corrective Action

1. Follow-up and corrective action is the responsibility of the manager in the surveyed area.

C. Assessment

1. The Safety Officer and Environment of Care Committee will periodically review the results of these activities to identify trends and areas of possible improvement.
