<u>PURPOSE</u>

To ensure all equipment, grounds, and building systems in the LAC+USC Medical Center operate as designed.

POLICY

A preventive maintenance program is established to ensure that building systems, grounds, and equipment are properly maintained.

PROCEDURE

- A computerized maintenance management system shall be used to generate work orders for preventive maintenance.
- Preventive maintenance schedules shall be available upon request.
- Equipment and building systems found to require different service schedules shall have their preventive maintenance schedule adjusted accordingly.
- Monthly reports shall be generated to indicate the percentage of preventive maintenance work orders completed. The reports shall be submitted to the Director of Facilities Management for review.

If scheduled maintenance cannot be performed due to non-availability of replacement parts, then service users shall be notified, and pertinent information shall be documented and monitored.
