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<u>PURPOSE</u>

To maintain the LAC+USC Medical Center water supply systems.

<u>POLICY</u>

The LAC+USC Medical Center water supply systems shall be maintained and monitored by Facilities Management staff to ensure the availability of water for human consumption, patient care, and fire protection.

PROCEDURE

Water supply management shall include:

- Hot water temperature maintained for the facilities' dietary and patient care areas;
- Clearly labeled outlets and piping for non-potable water;
- Major shut-off valves labeled;
- Maintenance and periodic inspection documented;
- Emergency plan which outlines water supply distribution and obtaining alternative water supply; and
- Quality control for dialysis
 - Water used for dialysis shall meet regulatory standards such as the Association for Advancement of Medical Instrumentation (AAMI).
 - Bacterial testing of water shall be completed as required.
 - Epidemiology shall verify the water quality and equipment maintenance records kept by the Renal Dialysis Unit.
