## PURPOSE

To establish guidelines for regulatory compliance of the fire protection systems.

## POLICY

The LAC+USC Medical Center shall establish and maintain fire protection systems for all buildings.

## DEFINITIONS

### **Fire Protection Systems:**

Fire alarm systems, sprinkler systems, fire hoses, rolling fire doors, Won-Door Fireguard™, fire extinguishers, fixed chemical fire suppression systems, smoke and heat detection systems, smoke and fire dampers, wet and dry standpipes.

## PROCEDURE

- Facilities Management staff shall manage the maintenance of the fire protection systems.
- Maintenance tracking program shall include service and inspection records of scheduled tests
- Conduct fire drills as defined by California Code of Regulations, local fire ordinance and Joint Commission standards.
