## **PURPOSE**

To ensure that all contractors and their employees work safely within the Medical Center facilities.

## **POLICY**

All contractors shall ensure that their employees are properly trained, equipped, and comply with all safety standards while working at the LAC+USC Medical Center facilities.

## **PROCEDURE**

- Contractors shall provide safety in-service training documents upon request.
- Contractors shall provide and ensure their employees use the proper protective equipment provided to them.
- Contractors shall ensure that their employees are free from communicable disease.
- Contractors shall inform Medical Center management immediately when the employees discover a potential hazard.
- Contractor shall discontinue work if the condition poses a serious threat to employee's health or life.
- Contractors shall inform the area administrator and the project coordinator whenever hazardous material is involved.
- Contractors shall provide Safety Data Sheets (SDS) upon request and have them readily available to their employees while at the work site.
- Contract employees shall be trained in the facility emergency response procedures prior to starting the project.
- Contractors shall comply with the Cal/OSHA Dual Employer Responsibility regulation.
