PURPOSE

To ensure the safety of all patients, visitors, and employees of LAC+USC Medical Center during fire and other emergencies.

POLICY

The LAC+USC Medical Center shall provide appropriate fire/life safety training for all employees in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

PROCEDURE

The fire/life safety training shall include the following topics:

- Basic fire procedure and responses to fire
- Fire prevention and chemistry of fires
- Use of fire extinguishers
- Evacuation and panic control
- Evacuated/Rescue Carries
- Fire drills
- Personal safety awareness
- Earthquake Preparedness
