### **PURPOSE**

To protect employees from hearing loss due to noise exposure at work.

## **POLICY**

The LAC+USC Medical Center shall develop, implement, and maintain a hearing conservation program whenever employee noise exposures equal or exceed Cal/OSHA's Action Level.

## **PROCEDURE**

Identify areas where noise could equal to or greater than 85 dBA on an 8 hour time weighted average (TWA) basis.

Collect noise exposure data from identified hazard areas.

If an employee's exposure equals or exceeds 85 dBA (8 hour TWA):

- Notify employee.
- Obtain noise measurements of the affected employee(s). The results of monitoring shall be shared with employee(s).
- Proper hearing protection must be provided to employees by management. Hearing
  protection used must have attenuation ability, as certified by the manufacturer, to
  sufficiently reduce the noise level below the exposure limits.
- Annual audiometric testing shall be made available to employee at no cost.
- Noise hazard sign shall be posted in affected areas.
- Provide noise safety education to employees.
