PURPOSE

To enforce the laws concerning parking on ambulance ramps and emergency areas.

POLICY

Parking on ambulance ramps by non-emergency vehicles without authorization are subject to citation and/or vehicle impoundment.

PROCEDURE

Authorized non-emergency vehicles transporting the following are permitted to park on an ambulance ramp.

- Any person in need of emergency medical attention.
- Emergency medical supplies delivery.

It is the responsibility of LASD to enforce traffic and parking codes.
