<u>PURPOSE</u>

To prevent the flow of illegal substances into or from the LAC+USC Medical Center facilities.

POLICY

The LAC+USC Medical Center shall adhere to all federal, State, and local laws, which prohibit the possession, use, sale, or trafficking of narcotics, non-prescription drugs, and other restricted, prohibited, or controlled substances. Possession of verifiable medical marijuana is exempt from this policy.

<u>DEFINITION</u>

Restricted supplies shall include, but not be limited to: syringes, needles, surgical instruments, or other such items that can be used to inject, inhale, or ingest any prohibited or controlled substance. A medical marijuana smoking instrument is exempt if in the possession of a person in possession of medical marijuana, which has been verified.
