SUBJECT: PATIENT HYGIENE AND BATHING

**STANDARDS** 

Policy No.: C104

Effective Date: 12/1993

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**Purpose of the Policy:** To establish a standard of nursing practice and documentation requirements related to patient hygiene.

Physician's Order Required: No

Performed By: RNs, LVNs, RAs, NAs, SNWs, and Affiliating Nursing Students under the supervision of an RN

**Equipment required:** Will vary according to patient's needs and abilities.

# **Definitions:**

Bathing:

Bed bath - full bath in bed

Partial bed bath – minimally includes face, hands, axillae, perineum

Shower - independent or assisted, standing or sitting

AM/PM Care: Washing of hands, face, oral hygiene, grooming

Oral Hygiene: Cleansing of mouth, teeth, tongue, gums, and prostheses (dentures)

Personal Grooming: Will vary related to patient needs. May include hair combing, deodorant, make-up, shaving

Incontinence Care: Skin inspection and cleansing following incontinence.

# **Policy Statements:**

- 1. Patients will receive daily hygiene appropriate to their individual needs and self-care abilities. This regimen includes bathing, oral hygiene, and personal grooming.
- 2. Supplemental hygiene measures (incontinence care, tracheostomy care, gastrostomy tube care, etc.) are provided according to each patient's needs.
- 3. Bathing equipment (tubs, shower trolleys, shower chairs, etc.) will be cleaned after each patient use with the hospital approved disinfectant.
- 4. Patient and caregiver will be taught and encouraged to participate in their care in order to promote/facilitate maximum independence.

## **Documentation:**

APPROVED BY:

- 1. All bathing and hygiene measure refusals and exceptions will be documented in the electronic health record (EHR).
- 2. Document patient/ caregiver teachings and achievements regarding bathing and hygiene in EHR.
