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## **PURPOSE:**

To establish guidelines for correcting errors in the Electronic Health Record (EHR).

## **POLICY:**

Harbor-UCLA Medical Center shall ensure that all corrections made in the EHR shall be consistent with good medical practice.

## **PROCEDURE:**

When an error is made while documenting in the EHR, corrections must be made by the author of the original entry as follows:

- 1. The original entry must be visible.
- 2. Document the reason for the correction/error.
- 3. Use current date and time for the correction.
- 4. In situations where there is a hard copy printed from the EHR, the hard copy must also be corrected.
