

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY AND PROCEDURE

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Subject: MEDICAL STAFF CHAIN OF COMMAND Policy No.: A108.1

PURPOSE:

To ensure that the appropriate medical staff is contacted to resolve problems related to patient care and/or altercations between staff.

POLICY:

The medical staff will maintain a Medical staff Chain of Command to ensure reporting of patient care related problems and/or altercations between staff to the appropriate physician level.

PROCEDURE:

The following chain of command/reporting protocol is followed for resolving problems related to patient care and/or altercations between staff:

- <u>Step 1</u> Notify the attending staff physician.

 If problem is not reasonably resolved, proceed with step 2.
- <u>Step 2</u> Notify the Chief of service or area or the Department Chair. If problem is not reasonably resolved, proceed with step 3.
- <u>Step 3</u> Notify the Assistant Chief Medical Officer. *If problem is not reasonably resolved, proceed with step 4.*
- Step 4 Notify the Chief Medical Officer.

Please make sure that you have fully exercised Steps 1-3 prior to proceeding with Step 4.
