SUBJECT: PATIENT CARE ASSIGNMENTS Policy No.: A420

PURPOSE OF PROCEDURE: To outline the method of completing patient care assignments based upon patient acuity and nursing ratio standards.

WHO CAN PERFORM: SSN I or Unit Charge Nurse

POLICY STATEMENT:

The process for assigning nursing staff to provide patient care is based on consideration of the following elements:

- 1. The complexity of the patient's condition and required nursing care.
- 2. The patient's status, including the frequency with which the need for specific nursing care activities changes.
- 3. The complexity of patient assessment and re-assessment with consideration for the knowledge, skills and competency required to perform accurate and timely patient assessment.
- 4. The type of technology utilized in the provision of nursing care, with consideration for the knowledge, competency and skill required.
- 5. The degree of supervision required for each individual member of the nursing staff.
- 6. The availability of appropriate supervision.
- 7. The principle of continuity of care which is consistency in assigning RN Primary Nurse/Team Leader for each patient from admission through discharge.
- 8. Relevant infection control and safety issues.

PROCEDURAL STEPS:

- 1. At the beginning of each shift, the SSNI or Registered Nurse Unit Charge will:
 - A. Assign all patients to nursing care givers, considering the above eight elements in making assignment decisions.
 - B. Complete the daily Shift Nursing Assignment sheet (Attachment 3 in **Staffing Policy, Nursing** policy #A301) and send Assessment of AB 394 Compliance section (Attachment 4 in **Staffing Policy, Nursing** policy #A301) to Nursing Resource Office (NRO) two hours prior to the end of the shift.
- 2. Daily assignment sheets will be maintained on the unit through the current Joint Commission cycle and then can be archived. See **Records Retention** policy #A160.
