#### PURPOSE

To ensure the Los Angeles General Medical Center provides considerate and respectful care to all patients.

### **POLICY**

The Los Angeles General Medical Center shall provide considerate and respectful care, including consideration of psychosocial, spiritual, and cultural values that influence perception of illness.

Medical Center administration shall ensure that patient services are provided by competent staff within an environment conducive to healing.

- Active surveillance through continuous quality improvement monitoring shall be established to ensure employee's appearance and/or performance meets the Medical Center's mission, goals, and value statement.
- Provide a continuum of care through collaborative practices in an interdepartmental, interdisciplinary setting.
- Provide information to the patient regarding technology and equipment utilized for their care.
- Maintain a safe, clean, and quiet environment.
- Mandatory orientation of all staff including, but not limited to, attending staff, housestaff, allied health professionals, and nursing staff to the basic requirements for providing patient services and care.
