# **PURPOSE**

The County of Los Angeles (County) and Los Angeles General Medical Center's (LA General Medical Center) has expended considerable time and resources in developing and protecting its valuable trademarks, copyrights, and other intellectual property. The purpose of this policy is to safeguard the County and LA General Medical Center's intellectual property, including seals, logos, marks, emblems, insignias, and names. This policy outlines the procedures for identifying, reporting, and addressing any improper use of the County/LA General's intellectual property by employees or external entities.

# **DEFINITIONS**

For the purpose of this document, "intellectual property" refers to the County of Los Angeles and Los Angeles General Medical Center seals, logos, marks, emblems, insignias, and names, which were created by or on behalf of the County/LA General.

## **POLICY**

Employees and vendors shall not use the County or LA General's Intellectual Property without express consent of the County or LA General. It is unlawful for a nongovernmental entity to use a seal, emblem, insignia, trade, or brand name in a manner that can be construed as implying federal, state, or local governmental approval, except in specific circumstances, including approval or endorsement by that governmental entity. This includes displaying County names, seals, and/or images on merchandise, and/or promotional materials, including clothing and novelty items.

# **PROCEDURE**

#### 1. Identification of Violators:

 Any employee observing the improper use of the County/LA General's Intellectual Property should make a note of the name(s) of individuals improperly using the Intellectual Property, location and details of the improper use, and specific violation.

# 2. Improper Use by Employees

 An employee does not have approval or license to display any non-sanctioned merchandise or promotional materials with the County seal or other County images,

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including the name and images associated with LA General Medical Center, without express approval.

- 3. Reporting Violations:
  - Report violations to the LA General Public Information Officer (PIO), providing details of the employee(s) involved in the improper use.

### RESPONSIBILITY

• LA Public Information Officer (PIO): Responsible for coordinating the delivery of ceaseand-desist letters to identified violators.

#### **REVIEW**

This policy will undergo periodic review to address any changes in intellectual property laws and ensure its continued effectiveness in protecting the County and LA General Medical Center's brand integrity.
