PURPOSE

To address continuity of care and to prevent duplication of services for youth transferred from the Probation facilities to the Sheriff's facility.

POLICY

When a youth is determined to be found "unfit" and transferred to the Sheriff's Century Regional Detention Facility in Lynwood, a copy of the Medical Discharge Summary and the youth's immunization card (yellow cardboard) will be sent to the Sheriff's Department.

PROCEDURE

When the HIM staff is notified by the medical staff at the Sheriff's Century Regional Detention Facility that they have received a youth from the Probation Department who was declared as "unfit", the HIM staff will do the following:

- 1. Request a Medical Discharge Summary from Nursing
- 2. Send the following to the Sheriff's Department:
 - Medical Discharge Summary
 - Youth's immunization card (Yellow card, DHS issued)

The medical records staff will send the information to:

The Presiding Judge's general medical consent for detained youth covers the release of this information to the Sheriff's Department.
