PURPOSE

To define JCHS policy regarding identification of health record contents, format, and recording methods.

POLICY

All youth medically admitted to a Probation Detention Facility shall have a health record. The health authority approves record contents, format, and the method of recording entries.

DEFINITION

SOAP

is an acronym used to describe the recording format within the problem-oriented health record

PROCEDURE

- 1. All clinical entries made in the health record shall be in the SOAP format as follows:
 - S: (SUBJECTIVE) Subjective history obtained regarding the patient
 - O: (OBJECTIVE) Objective physical examination data obtained during the physical examination of the patient.
- A: (ASSESSMENT) Working diagnosis or assessment of the patient's physical condition; may include discussion.
- P: (PLAN) Treatment plan for the patient that provides for medication, activity instructions, diet, referrals, etc.
- 2. The health record content will consist of the following:
 - The completed initial health screening form
 - Health appraisal data forms
 - Master problem list
 - All findings, diagnoses, treatments, and dispositions
 - Prescribed medicines and their administration
 - Reports of laboratory, radiology, and diagnostic studies
 - Signature and title of each documenter and date and time of recording
 - Consent and refusal forms, when applicable
