PURPOSE

To be in compliance with the Medical Waste Management Act for transporting infectious waste to a hazardous waste storage facility.

POLICY

Juvenile Court Health Services (JCHS) maintains compliance with all Federal and State laws and regulations regarding transporting infectious waste.

PROCEDURE

JCHS and/or a contract agency will maintain on file a record of the following:

- All medical waste transported off the site for disposal
- Appropriate gross weight
- Date transported
- Name of person(s) hauling the waste and final destination
- Medical waste tracking document will also be in place

The Probation Department camps generate less than 20 pounds of regulated medical waste per week and transport less than the given amount at any one time.
