# Juvenile Court Health Services Facility Specific Manual Campus Vernon Kilpatrick

Campus Vernon Kilpatrick (CVK) is located at 427 South Encinal Road, Malibu, CA 90265. CVK is a Los Angles County Probation Facility. Youth are housed in 5 cottages that have a maximum census of 24 each. The cottages are where the youth eat, sleep, and tend to their activities of daily living. Currently only two are occupied.

The clinical area consists of the Medical Unit with two exam rooms. There are also separate offices for the facility Psychiatrists and other Mental Health Staff. Youth receive their medications in their cottages. Some minor medical services can be provided in the cottage but most medical services occur in the Medical area.

## **Nursing Hours of Operation**

There is a Registered Nurse on duty seven (7) days a week from 0600-2200. In the event the staff on duty is unable to resolve any incident, the Nurse Supervisor and/or the Nurse Manager can be reached via cellphone. See Nurse On-Call List.

# **Physician Hours of Operation**

There is a Physician Clinic held one day a week. If a Physician consult is required outside of the clinic hours the notification procedure below can be followed:

- During physician clinic hours: Notify the Physician on Duty at Barry J. Nidorf Juvenile Hall.
- On weekends from 7:30 AM to 4 PM: Notify the Physician on Duty at Central Juvenile Hall.
- All other times: Contact the Physician On Call (refer to Physician Call schedule).

#### **Dental Services**

Youth requiring Dental Services are transported to Central Juvenile Hall via Probation Transportation. Referral to Dental Services is initiated by physician or nursing staff.

#### **Pharmacy Services**

Medication is routinely delivered Monday through Saturday via a Pharmacy Driver from Central Juvenile Hall (CJH) where the main pharmacy is located. A Pyxis machine is located here and is regularly stocked and maintained by the pharmacists.

# **Optometry Services**

Youth requiring Optometry Services are transported to Central Juvenile Hall to visit the Eye Clinic. Referral to Optometry Services is initiated by physician or nursing staff.

# **Mental Health Services**

Youth requiring Mental Health Services are seen at BJNJH by the Department of Mental Health (DMH) – Juvenile Justice Mental Health Program staff. Referral to Mental Health Services can be initiated by Probation, Physician or Nursing.

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# **Outside Medical Services**

Youth requiring outside medical services and/or specialty appointments are typically transported by Probation to LAC+USC Healthcare Network located at 1200 North State Street, Los Angeles, CA 90033 or to Olive View Medical Center (a Los Angeles County facility) located at 14445 Olive View Dr., Sylmar, CA 91342 depending on the medical needs of the youth.

# **Medical Emergencies/First-Aid**

Nursing staff is on-site and available 8 hours a day, 7 days a week to provide first aid and assist with medical emergencies. In the event of any medical emergency, any staff may access care by calling "911".

# **Management of Contagious Diseases**

For any suspected or confirmed contagious diseases, notify the Infection Control Manager at (323) 839-6225 for direction and the physician on duty/on-call.

# **Health Information Management (HIM)**

The HIM Department is located at the Barry J. Nidorf, Central, and Los Padrinos Juvenile Halls. The staff is on-site Monday to Friday. They are assigned to prepare charts for youth movement (transport), scan documents into Probation Electronic Medical Record System (PEMRS) and handle the release of medical information.

# **Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE)**

In accordance with Section 889 of the Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC) of the state of California, the county superintendent of schools is directed to establish and maintain public schools at the elementary or secondary level with the primary purpose for education of youth.

#### **Probation Services**

The Department of Probation is under the jurisdiction of the juvenile justice system and is considered as the legal guardian (locus parentis) of the youth. Upon initial arrival at the campus, the youth is orientated to procedures and protocols (e.g. Access to Care) by Probation staff.
