

# Riley Infant Pain Scale Assessment Tool

Behavior	Scoring			
	0	1	2	3
<b>Facial</b>	Neutral/smiling	Frowning/grimacing	Clenched teeth	Full cry expression
<b>Body Movement</b>	Calm, relaxed	Restless/fidgeting	Moderate agitation or moderate mobility	Thrashing, flailing, incessant agitation or strong voluntary immobility
<b>Sleep</b>	Sleeping quietly with easy respirations	Restless while asleep	Sleeps intermittently (sleep/awake)	Sleeping for prolonged periods of time interrupted by jerky movements or unable to sleep
<b>Verbal/vocal</b>	No cry	Whimpering, complaining	Pain crying	Screaming, high-pitched cry
<b>Consolability</b>	Neutral	Easy to console	Not easy to console	Inconsolable
<b>Response to Movement/Touch</b>	Moves easily	Winces when touched/moved	Cries out when moved/touched	High-pitched cry or scream when touched or moved
