**PURPOSE:** To ensure that the temperature and humidity of the Operating Rooms

(OR), in the Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC), are tracked and

maintained within recommended ranges.

**POLICY:** The temperature of all ORs shall be maintained between 68 and 73

degrees Fahrenheit (20 – 23 degrees Celsius).

The humidity of all ORs shall be maintained between 30 to 60%.

## PROCEDURE:

- 1. Temperature and humidity in the ORs must be maintained within the above-stated standards to inhibit microbial growth, reduce risk of infection, control odor and promote patient comfort.
- 2. At the beginning of each work day, temperature and humidity for each OR suite will be checked by nursing staff and the results will be kept in the OR Temperature/Humidity book, housed in the Medication Room.
- 3. When temperature and/or humidity are recorded out of range, the High Desert Regional Health Center (HDRHC) Facilities Department will be notified.
- 4. Upon notification of out of range temperature and/or humidity readings, HDRHC Facilities will dispatch staff to adjust room temperatures and recheck monitoring with ASC nursing staff.
- 5. If the humidity and temperature levels are outside of the parameters, surgery will be held until corrected. If unable to correct, the procedure will be cancelled or moved to another OR.
