PURPOSE: To describe criteria for admission of observers to the Ambulatory Surgery

Center (ASC) operating room (OR) and the guidelines regarding

observers' behavior.

POLICY: The following guidelines will be adhered to when dealing with observers in

the OR.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Individuals who may be allowed to observe, with permission and consent from the patient, are:
 - Medical Doctors or Medical Personnel employed by High Desert Health System and/or the ASC
 - Trained medical company representatives
 - Nursing students.
- 2. Family members are not permitted at any time during surgery.
- 3. If a sales representative/medical vendor will be present during the procedure, the surgeon must discuss this with the patient prior to the procedure. The discussion will be documented in the patients EHR.
- 4. Observers name and purpose will be documented on the imed consent, in the "Observers" section, prior to obtaining patient's consent for procedure.
- 5. Observers must be dressed in appropriate OR attire, including scrubs, shoe covers, cap and mask.
- 6. Observers must perform a thorough hand washing, just prior to entering and immediately after leaving the OR.
- 7. Observers will be directed where to stand or sit, during the procedure, by the circulating nurse.

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- 8. Observers are not allowed or authorized to touch OR equipment other than their specific company equipment. At no time are observers authorized to touch the patient.
- 9. Observers are instructed regarding the removal of their equipment by either the circulating nurse or scrub technician.
- 10. Observers must place their used scrubs/cover clothing in the appropriate dressing room hamper.
