Instructions:

All patients presenting to Ambulatory Care are to be assessed for possible Post-Operative Surgical Site Infections (SSIs).

- 1. Ask the patient if he/she had a surgical procedure done at HDHS ASC within the last 90 days.
  - a. If no, STOP. Do not report to Infection Prevention and Control.
  - b. If yes, proceed to question #2.
- 2. Ask the patient if he/she is presenting to the clinic with any of the following complaints related to the surgical procedure done at HDHS ASC within the last 90 days:
  - a. Pain
  - b. Fever
  - c. Tiredness
  - d. Redness at site
  - e. Swelling at site
  - f. Warmth at site
  - g. Abscess
  - h. Cellulitis
  - i. Necrosis
  - j. Purulent drainage/Discharge at site
  - k. Dehiscence/Wound opening
- 3. A. If the patient does not report any of the above complaints, then STOP. Do not report to the Infection Prevention and Control Office.
  - B. If the patient does report any of the above complaints, then send Post Op Wound Infection Report form (fax: 661-524-2970 or mail) or call (661-471-4260) the Infection Prevention and Control Office to report the possible SSI.
