## **PURPOSE:**

To outline the process established for monitoring Medical Board of California (MBC) Accusations, which have been filed against a physician with clinical privileges at High Desert Health System Ambulatory Surgical Center.

## **PROCEDURE:**

- The Medical Board of California (MBC) Administrative Actions are monitored on a monthly basis by the Medical Staff Coordinator and the Medical Director and are forwarded to the Medical Advisory Committee (ASC Credentials Committee) on a monthly basis for review.
- 2. If an accusation is discovered for a physician with clinical privileges at the HDHS ASC, the Medical Staff Coordinator shall notify the Chief of Service and the Medical Director immediately upon receipt of notification.
- 3. The Medical Staff Coordinator shall contact the MBC for a copy of the accusation within 30 days of notification.
- 4. Once the copy of the accusation is received, it shall be referred to the Medical Advisory Committee (ASC Credentials Committee) at its next regularly scheduled meeting for review and appropriate action.
- 5. The Medical Staff Coordinator will note the accusation on the Sanctions Monitoring Log and will follow-up on actions taken by the MBC. Accusations will be monitored by the Medical Staff Coordinator and reported to the Medical Advisory Committee (ASC Credentials Committee) until the matter has been resolved.
