PURPOSE: To provide guidelines on proper documentation of implantable devices.

POLICY: Ambulatory Surgical Center staff are required to complete the proper documentation when implants are used in a surgical procedure.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Implantable devices include but are not limited to the following:
 - A. Orthopedic/Podiatric plates, screws, nails, pins, wires, etc.
 - B. GYN fallopian rings and Hulks clips
 - C. ENT myringotomy tubes
 - D. Vascular
 - E. Tissue
- 2. General Surgery Mesh Sticker for implanted item, if available, will be placed in the Surgeon's Report of Operation (progress note)
- 3. The following will be documented in the patient's medical record:
 - A. Name of implanted item
 - B. Size and total amount if multiples implanted
 - C. Where device is located
 - D. Company name
 - E. Lot number
 - F. Serial number of implanted item
