**PURPOSE:** To describe the procedure that ensures accountability in the event of a

controlled drug loss.

**POLICY:** When controlled drugs are classified as lost, the following procedure will

be completed with.

#### **DEFINITION:**

Control Drug Loss: When any of the following situations is applicable to a controlled drug:

- Spilled (liquid) or dropped on the floor
- · Accidental breakage of ampule, vial, or injectable cartridge
- Contents damaged or missing from a secured controlled drug package with a broken seal
- Missing

### PROCEDURE:

- When a controlled drug from the Controlled Drug Drawer of the Pyxis machine is deemed to be lost, a Controlled Drug Reporting Form must be completed as follows:
  - a. The form is completed by the nurse or provider reporting the loss.
  - b. If the medication needs to be discarded, a witness must sign the form.
  - c. The completed form is forwarded to ASC Nursing Director or designee.
  - d. The ASC Nursing Director or designee assigns a number, from the Lost
  - e. The ASC Nursing Director or designee, reviews and signs the completed form.

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- f. The completed form is forwarded to the ASC Medical Director and the Pharmacy Director for signature.
- g. The original signed form will be kept in the ASC Medical Director's office.
- 2. A report of the loss will be entered into the SI system.
- The Loss of Controlled Drug Reporting Forms are kept on file in the ASC for a period of at least three years.
- 4. A trend report of losses of controlled drugs will be presented to the ASC Medical Advisory Committee when any action is required to be taken by the Committee.
- In instances of missing controlled drugs, the Medical Director's designee must complete a Form DEA-106, Report of Theft or Loss of Controlled Substances on the DEA website (<a href="http://www.deadiversion.usdoj.gov/">http://www.deadiversion.usdoj.gov/</a>). The report will be forwarded to:
  - a. Original and one copy to the Drug Enforcement Agency, Los Angeles Office within 24 hours of discovery
  - b. California State Board of Pharmacy within 30 days of discovery
  - c. ASC Administration
  - d. ASC Medical Director
  - e. HDHS Pharmacy Director
