PURPOSE: To describe the smoking policy at High Desert Regional Health Center

(HDRHC) Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) for patients, the public, and

employees.

POLICY: Smoking shall not be permitted anywhere on HDRHC ASC property in

order to reduce risks of possible adverse effects on care, treatment, and services and to reduce the risk of passive smoke for others and of fire.

PROCEDURE:

- A. Signage addressing the smoking policy shall be posted at the ASC waiting area.
- B. The sign shall clearly state "No Smoking" and/or display the international no smoking Symbol.
- C. An employee's failure to observe the smoke-free policy may result in a citation from Law Enforcement.
- D. Continued violation of the smoke-free policy may result in progressive discipline including discharge.
- E. Employee shall include volunteers, contractors, students, and County employees.
