# SUBJECT: SURGICAL VACUUM FAILURE

#### POLICY:

The High Desert Health system will identify and implement processes for emergency procedures in the event of a system failure, as per State Regulatory Standards.

## PURPOSE:

To ensure constant operation of the Medical/Surgical Vacuum system.

## PROCEDURE:

In the event of a failure of this system:

- 1. The ASC supervisor and the Facilities front office are to be immediately notified.
- 2. An electrician and plumber are to be dispatched to diagnose and correct the problem, repairs are to made immediately.
- 3. Portable suction machines shall be delivered to effected areas, as needed.
- 4. Create a work order.

Upon the system being restored to normal operation, notify the ASC and Facilities front office.

Facility staff will assist in whatever way necessary to expedite the process.
