SUBJECT: De-identify Patient Information

PURPOSE:

To ensure the patient identifiable information is blacked out prior to sending that information in cases of reviews or research where the identifiable information is not needed.

PROCEDURE:

Using black marker, mark through all identifiable information as indicated below:

- 1. Names
- 2. Street Address, City, State, County, and Zip Code
- 3. All elements of dates(except year) directly related to an individual including:
 - a. Birth date
 - b. Admission date
 - c. Discharge date
 - d. Date of death
- 4. Telephone numbers
- 5. Fax numbers
- 6. E-mail addresses
- 7. Social Security numbers
- 8. Medical record numbers
- 9. Health plan beneficiary numbers
- 10. Account numbers
- 11. Certificate/license numbers
- 12. Vehicle identifiers and serial numbers(including license plate numbers)
- 13. Devise identifiers and serial numbers
- 14. Web Universal Resource Locators (URLs)
- 15. Internal Protocol (IP) Address numbers
- 16. Biometric identifiers, including finger/voice prints
