SUBJECT: 2007 ANTELOPE VALLEY HEALTH CENTER PRENATAL AND FAMILY PLANNING CLINICS – PRESCRIPTION DISPENSING

- **PURPOSE:** To provide policy and procedures for the dispensing of prescription medications in the Antelope Valley Health Center (AVHC) Prenatal and Family Planning Clinics.
- **POLICY:** Physicians and Nurse Practitioners with furnishing numbers can prescribe medications to patients. Registered Nurses may assist the prescribing provider by giving the prescription to the patient after the prescription has been properly labeled by the prescribing provider.

POLICY GUIDELINES:

All medications can be prescribed by a physician or nurse practitioner only. The prescription will include the following information:

- a. Clinic name, address, and telephone number, pre-printed.
- b. Drug name, route, quantity, strength, instructions for use.
- c. Patient's name and medical record number.
- d. Signature of prescribing Physician or Nurse Practitioner.
