## SUBJECT: PHARMACY SERVICES

**Purpose:** To describe the process for patients at High Desert Health System (HDHS)

Ambulatory Care primary care clinics to have prescriptions filled.

**Policy:** The HDHS Pharmacy will fill prescriptions written by providers at HDHS

Ambulatory Care Clinics.

## Procedure:

- Patients receiving services at Ambulatory Care clinics will be informed that they have the following options to have prescriptions filled: 1) community pharmacies (using their own resources or program coverage, if applicable), and 2) the HDHS Pharmacy. Community Health Plan (CHP) patients should be referred to the CHP pharmacy network.
- 2. The HDHS Pharmacy is open Monday-Friday from 8:30 a.m. 5:00 p.m., and closed on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.
- 3. The Exempt Drug List provides a mechanism through which the HDHS Pharmacy can provide medications free of charge when a patient does not have sufficient resources to purchase the required medication and does not have third party coverage (see Policy 912 Exempt Drug List).

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
